

SESSION 5: THY KINGDOM COME

IV. Thy Kingdom Come:

- A. Matt 6:9 – Our Father/Kingdom Come thy will be done/on earth as heaven
- B. Matthew 4:23-24 – "He went around all of Galilee, **teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people.** His fame spread to all of Syria, and they brought to him all who were sick with various diseases and racked with pain, those who were possessed, lunatics, and paralytics, and he cured them."
- C. Luke 17:20-21 – "Asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, he said in reply, "The coming of the kingdom of God cannot be observed, 21 and no one will announce, 'Look, here it is,' or, 'There it is. For behold, the kingdom of God is among you.'"
- D. Romans 14:7 – "For the kingdom of God is not a matter of food and drink, but of righteousness, peace, and joy in the holy Spirit;"

V. Define : Church Living in a Kingdom Culture-The Normal Every Day Life Style of The Christian:

- A. Church – Body of Christ (actually not metaphorically,) which has dominion
- B. Living – Actively abiding in the realm of Life
- C. Kingdom Defined – Greek (Basileia) Noun, Sovereignty, Royal Power, Dominion, The place were a King has Dominion
- D. Dominion defined – Greek Kratos, Might, Power, Strength, force, MANIFESTED POWER
- E. Culture – *Webster's Definition:* The ideas, customs, skills of a given people with the result of development or improvement or refinement of the mind, emotions, interests, manners, tastes, the result is a refined way of thinking, talking, and acting.

Living in a Kingdom Culture Means:

The Church actively living as the Body of Jesus Christ; taking its place in Christ, allowing His manifested power, might, dominion, and strength to reside. Renewing our minds and emotions to the customs, ideas, and skills of this new creation reality, which will result in transforming the way we think, talk and act.
