## Read John 17

*Journal about the power transferred by (Words) Gospel.*

*Journal about how out of heart flows issues (forces of Life). How is YOUR heart?*

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# Session #7 Weekly Devotional: Day 3

## Read Matthew 12:22-37

*Journal about out of the abundance of heart (connected to heaven) the mouth (connected to earth) will speak.*

**F= Focus** in your journal by writing the date and the Scripture you're studying. After you've read the passage a few times, focus on a verse or two that stands out to you and then write out those verses in your journal.

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**I = Investigate** the context around today's Scripture reading. *To whom was this written? Why? How does this passage fit with what comes before and after it? What is the Holy Spirit communicating through this text?
